Kearns previously performed the role of "Faust" with Opera Ireland -- nominated for best production by the Irish Times Theater Awards in 2006.

The production will be conducted by Maestro Paul Nadler, who has led over 60 performances with the Metropolitan Opera, conducting stars such as Luciano Pavarotti and Placido Domingo. In addition to Kearns, it will feature top performers including: Lina Tetriani as "Marguerite," Gary Simpson as "Mephistopheles," Luis Ledesma as "Valentin," Misty Bermudez as "Siebel,"Evan Thomas Jones as "Wagner," and Melissa Vitrella as "Marthe."
