## Maryland Public Television to honor veterans with live musical production starring Tenor Anthony Kearns

"America's Veterans: A Musical Tribute" to air live on MPT on Sunday, November 11

WASHINGTON, Nov. 8, 2012 -- On Sunday, Nov. 11 at 7 p.m., The United States Air Force Band will once again proudly partner with Maryland Public Television to honor those who have served in all branches of the military with a live Veterans Day broadcast of "America's Veterans: A Musical Tribute."
